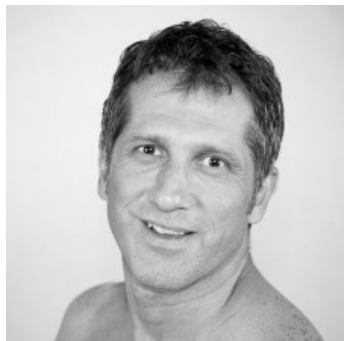
\*Intermediate Pilates is one hour and Intermediate Jazz is 1.5 hours on Tuesdays/Thursdays w/ lunch from 11:30-12
